My name is Branko and I`m brand new reviewer here at BST. I`ve been following mostly american sports like NHL and MLB, but I like also football and eurohockey. I`ve been trading these sports mostly on Betfair but occasionally I use local bookies too.

Now in front of us is brand new laying tips service. It`s called **LayEzyfootball**. A few days ago they opened a 14-days no-obligation free trial. They claim to provide a complete service regarding research and match analysis from 11 football leagues from Europe. So lay betting service cover leagues like England, Scotland, Germany, Belgium, Holland, Italy, France etc. During summer time they provide tips from Brasil, Sweden, Japan and American MLS.

All tips are delivered by mail the day before kickoff. The Lay betting expert behind this service is Neale Franklin and so far this season he has very good and promising results. Over 150% increase of initial bank.

Maximum lay odds for all bets are 6.0, and if a selection ends up not being available to bet within our odds range it will be considered void and not included in our official results.

Initial review of *LayEzyfootball* will be 56 days and may be extended to 84 "betting days". An initial bank of 20 to 30 points is recommended. For the purpose of this review I will start with 100pts initial bank with 3pts per lay at level stakes.

After 14-days trial you have to choose membership program 3 -6 or 12 months. Price is currently not available. Refund policy will be available up to 30 days from purchase date.

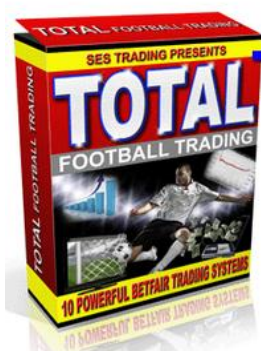

TFT Total Football Trading – Final Review

Three of us have reviewed 5 different trading strategies in the Total Football Trading package. There are an additional five strategies in the package that we

have not reviewed.

Total Football Trading weighs in at four hefty pdf files (a total of 11.5MB). It currently costs \$77 and for this you get ten different football trading strategies.

Each strategy is described in detail as to trading entry points, exit points and likely success rate. Match selection is perhaps a little less detailed, but I believe a careful read of each strategy should lead you to the right decisions. Each strategy then has several real examples with screen shots of the trades, these help you to understand the strategy.

I didn't mention it in the Introduction, but for the strategies, common reasons are given for why some people fail with each strategy – a useful feature, telling you how to avoid those mistakes.

It's probably best to just take one, two or three of the strategies and concentrate on them, rather than trying to do more. So there is probably a total of several months of comprehension and testing of the material that you buy. This package is particularly useful for those new to trading and football betting. It is also useful for more experienced traders who might need a refresher course on the basics.

There are pre-kick-off strategies and in-play strategies. Obviously, during the trading period, whether it be before kick-off or in-play, you do need to be able to watch the Betfair (or BetDAQ) markets. So you will need to be professional about what you do and not allow yourself to be sidetracked.

It is not possible to say that any other user would have the same success that our reviewers have had, as individuals will make different decisions at different times.

Of the five strategies that we tested four of them made a profit and one made a small loss. For these reviews we tried to run each one with a comparable staking level and betting bank. In total the five tests made 436.15points profit which averages at 87.23 points profit per strategy to a starting bank of 1,000 points each. That starting bank proved to be more than enough to cover bets. Because you initially might be laying, you do need a sufficient bank to support the lay bet, but due to safety exit strategies, with discipline, this bank is never put under threat.

Overall the five tested strategies averaged over 8% profit in 12 weeks – better than any high street bank can give you. Please, however read the individual reviews, to realize that sometimes quite a lot of time is taken up monitoring matches. All the more reason to have a selection of the strategies in your armoury, so that you can apply one or more technique for the same amount of time in monitoring matches.

Profit is profit and regular readers will know that many, many of our reviews don't make a profit! I would be amazed if any reader could not turn a profit using a selection of these strategies. So long as they are applied with discipline.

Bearing in mind that all three of the reviewers made a profit (with individual pass ratings of 3.5, 3.5 and 3 stars) and that there are five more strategies in the package, I think an overall pass of 3.5 stars is fair. Please note that one reviewer (Sgt Magnifique) thought an overall pass of 3 stars was the correct rating.

So overall I am giving Total Football Trading a 3.5 star pass.

A reasonable way of comparing the performance of systems is to work out the profit (or loss) as a percentage of the starting bank. Obviously this table doesn't replace reading the reviews, because *profit as %age of bank* is not the only factor in judging a system. Nevertheless, it is a valid at-a-glance way of bringing the mass of data together.

I've colour coded the reviews that are the currently most successful, with the colour of their profitability graph (next newsletter section) to make them easier to spot.

Place Bet Pro has dropped down the table. But we still have four reviews making a decent profit.

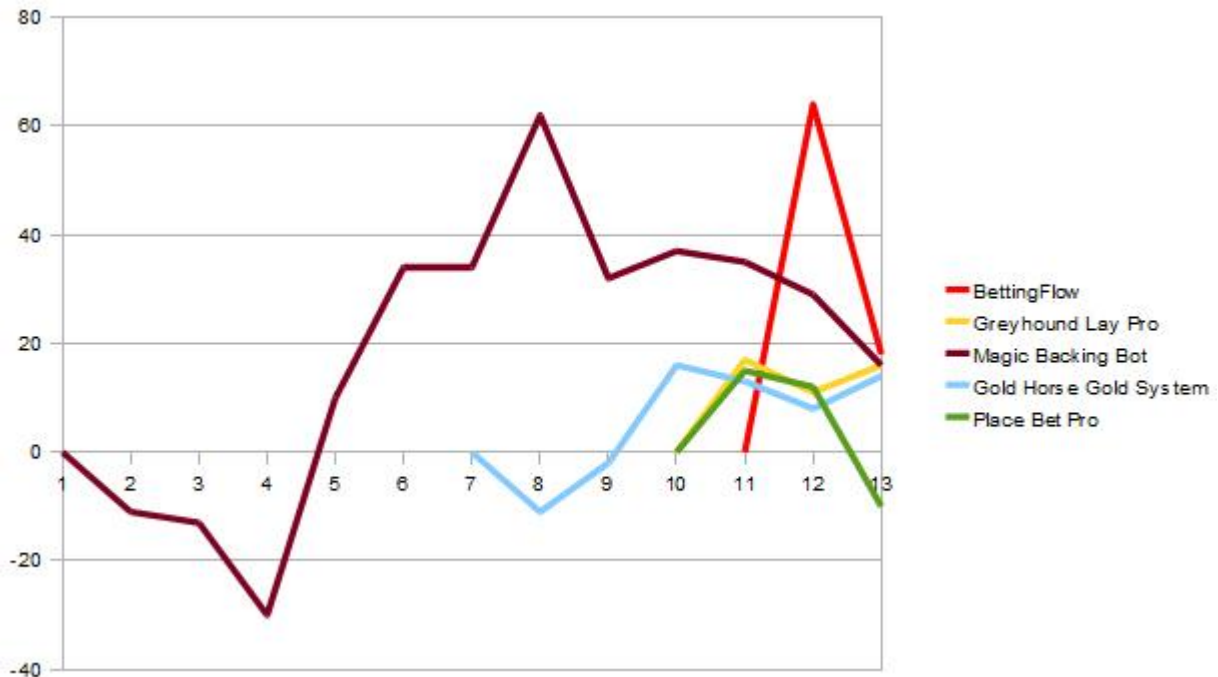


Here is a graph of the profit being made by the front-runners as a percentage of their starting bank. This gives a week by week comparative view of their progress.

It gives a representation of the volatility or dependability of each system. Ideally we would want a graph that increased each week by roughly the same amount. If a system or tipping service could produce that, then we would really have a winning review!

BettingFlow and Magic Backing have had a bad week. Greyhound Lay Pro and Gold Horse have steadily improved. Anything that makes going on for 20% profit is worth watching.
